Brandon and his wife, Lydia, went to Walmart and purchased items to make hygiene kits to pair with the sweaters. They then passed out roughly 30 kits to individuals living in homeless encampments in Fullerton, California.

But it doesn't stop there. Brandon keeps his eyes open for any time he can share about God's unfinished work. Brandon recently shared his testimony with a homeless man he met. This man proceeded to tell Brandon that he had been praying for a sign from God about how to get out of his current situation, and he felt like God brought Brandon to him. Brandon went with the man to Eastside's Care and Recovery Group, and he helped put the man in contact with a potential job.

Brandon is intentional about where he goes, what he does and how he represents what God has done in his life. His latest intentional move...getting an Unfinished tattoo on his forearm.
