Unfinished Story

At the start of Eastside's Unfinished initiative, our Compassion Team began dreaming up ways, big and small, that we could be a conduit of unprecedented hope to hurting people in our communities and around the world

Recently, our team was excited to connect with an organization called Blue Skies. This ministry offers hope through beach camps and mountain getaways designed to lift families above the clouds of childhood cancer. Blue Skies has historically served families on the East Coast, with the dream that someday they would be able to bring support, comfort, joy, and hope to families fighting the same fight here on the West Coast.

When our Compassion Team learned about their dream and what was needed to make West Coast retreats a success, our team jumped in! The very first 4-day event was hosted in Huntington Beach, and served 11 families with children fighting cancer — including 2 Eastside families!

Because of YOUR generosity, our team was able to step in and provide meals for everyone involved, family members and Blue Skies leaders alike. Eastside volunteers participated in and supported activities each day including games, devotional times, pool time, etc. This not only helped these kiddos feel normal and make memories, but it also allowed the parents of these warriors to connect with each other, get some much-needed rest, and be encouraged.

On the last night of the retreat, a team made up of an Eastside small group and volunteers helped to plan, prepare, and throw a Luau for all of the families on the sands of Huntington Beach. Not only was it filled with fun activities like an authentic hula show and lesson, beach limbo, and s'mores, but we concluded with a medal ceremony for all the warriors and their siblings who have sacrificed and endured so much!

By the vanishing light of sunset, we circled up and prayed a blessing over them as they headed back home for treatments, doctor's appointments, challenging schedules, and the nearly endless demands on their time and energy.
